Adref's Residential Services Division manages two Direct Access Hostels providing temporary accommodation for homeless people, and a housing scheme for young vulnerable people. The accommodation is linked to support which residents receive during their stay and help in accessing permanent accommodation in the community. The support varies depending on the needs of the individual tenant, but can include:

Practical support, such as:

- Benefit advice (both welfare and housing related)
- Help with filling in forms
- Help with budgeting and/or debt management
- Advice about moving into a new home etc.
- Setting up your home
- Vocational support in respect to all aspects of training, education or employment

Emotional support, such as:

- Advice and guidance
- Someone to listen to and talk over your problems with
- Access to specialist agencies providing long term support

Personal advocacy, such as:

- Representing scheme users in dealings with statutory bodies such as DWP and Housing Benefit

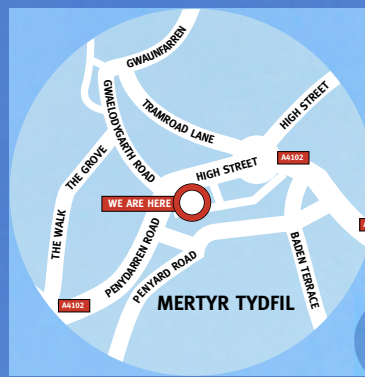

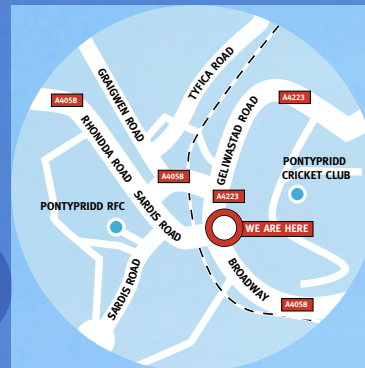
Mill Street Direct Access Hostel - Pontypridd
