Tenancy Support

Adref's tenancy support projects are designed to assist people who might otherwise struggle to establish or maintain a tenancy and live independently. This includes help and support for vulnerable individuals, for people who may have never previously lived independently or assistance for people who have previously experienced difficulty in maintaining a tenancy.

what we offer

Adref's tenancy support schemes provide time limited housing related support services to enable people to live independently in their own homes. The support varies depending on the needs of the individual tenant, but can include:

Practical support including:

- Benefit advice (both welfare and housing related)
- Help with filling in forms
- Help with budgeting and/or debt management
- Advice about moving into a new home etc.
- Setting up your home
- Vocational support in respect to all aspects of training, education or employment

Emotional support including:

- Advice and guidance
- Someone to listen to and talk over your problems with
- Access to specialist agencies providing long term support

Personal advocacy which includes:

- Representing scheme users in dealings with statutory bodies such as DWP and Housing Benefit

who we are

Adref is a housing charity which provides a range of housing related support services for homeless / potentially homeless and inappropriately housed people in both the Rhondda Cynon Taff and Merthyr Tydfil County Borough Council areas.

As well as providing direct access hostel accommodation, Adref currently manages five projects which provide tenancy related support and help with the development of independent living skills to people in their own homes.

These five projects are:

- The Rhondda Cynon Taff Tenancy Support Scheme (11 spaces)
- The RCT Young Persons Floating Support Scheme (6 spaces for individuals aged between the ages of 16-21)
- The RCT New Start Scheme (10 spaces for people with some form of criminal justice issues)
- The Merthyr Tydfil Local Authority Tenancy Support Scheme (10 spaces)
- The Merthyr Tydfil New Start Scheme (4 spaces for probation clients)

Together with the Aspire Project, which provides vocational support to all Adref's clients, these schemes form Adref's Community Support Services Division.
